Most nurses would prefer to work for an employer where they have control over their working hours.



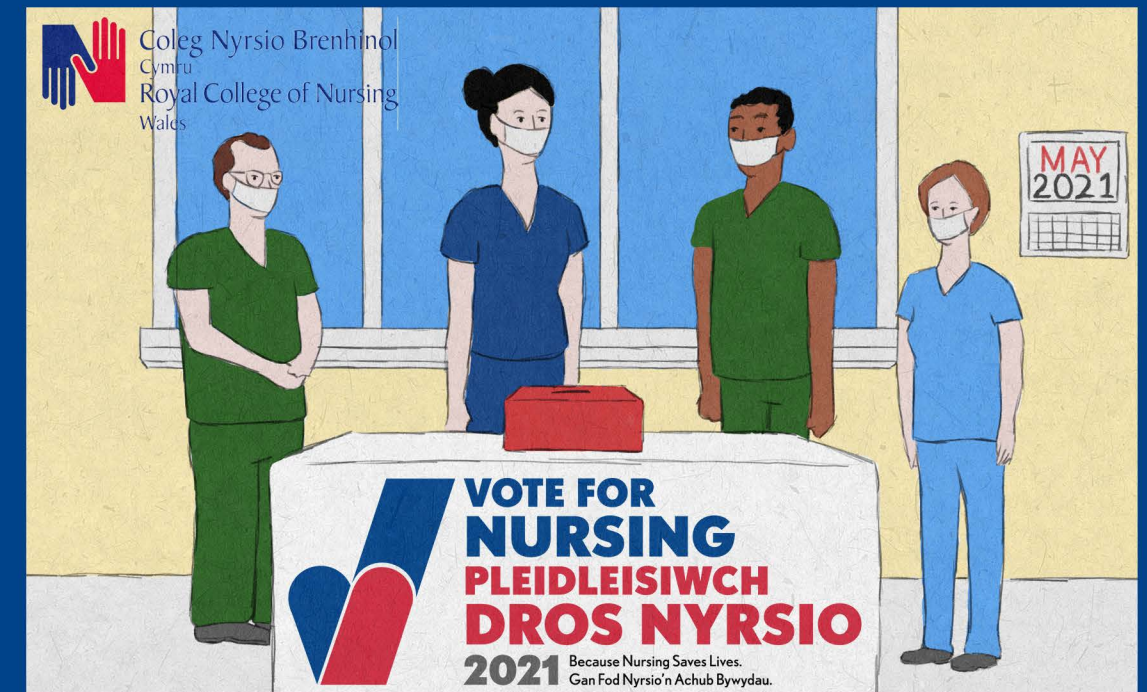
If employers including NHS Wales want to keep their nurses, they need to introduce flexible working.
